All current artist members will be listed on the home page at www.sonyaonline.org with links to their own web page in the online gallery. Members' pages include: member's name, 100-word bio or artist statement, 2 images of artwork, contact information (optional) and a link(s) to member's own website(s).

SONYA GROUP EMAIL

All members of SONYA are included in our group email list at sonyany@yahoogroups.com. This members-only email group enables our artist members to share news and creative opportunities with each other by sending an email to one address. Currently there are over 70 members using the group email.

SONYA DISCOUNTS

Artist members receive an annual membership card that can be used to receive discounts at SONYA sponsored workshops and other events.

GROUP EXHIBITIONS

Artist members of at least one year's tenure are eligible to participate in group exhibitions at our office/gallery space at 394 Waverly Ave, Brooklyn, NY 11238. All active artist members are eligible for participation in at least one SONYA sponsored group show per year.

FEES AND DONATIONS

The annual active artist membership fee starts at \$45, plus 6 hours of volunteer work during the membership year (January to December). Fee payments made after November 1st will be credited to the following membership year. If volunteer time is not desirable or possible, artists may pay the annual non-volunteer membership fee of \$100. There will be separate program fees for participation in SONYA exhibitions and programs, such as the Studio Stroll (\$25.). Artists may join SONYA at any time during the year.

VOLUNTEER TIME

Artists who have elected the reduced fee plus volunteer time will be contacted by the Volunteer Coordinator to match their interests, skills, and schedule with the tasks that need to be done. The volunteer areas include answering phone calls, posting flyers, preparing press packets, producing brochures, proofreading the web site hanging exhibitions, hosting gallery hours, hosting receptions, grant writing, press relations, etc.

SONYA STUDIO STROLL & PRELUDE EXHIBITION 2008

**SATURDAY, MAY 17 & SUNDAY, MAY 18,
12:00 PM – 6:00 PM RAIN OR SHINE**

The Studio Stroll is a self-guided tour of registered artists' studios and galleries in the SONYA community that attracts over a thousand visitors each year. The event is free and open to the public. Tour-goers will follow a **NEW** tour map that will give them studio/gallery locations, a brief description of each artist's work, and travel directions.

This is our 9th annual Studio Stroll! We have a whole **NEW** look! We will finally have two Members Only Stroll Nights, where Stroll Artists get to see each other's work. Also, **NEW** – we hired a coordinator for our Champagne Curators Tour. **NEW!** We will have a Stroll Welcome Center at IOI Gallery at 85 Ft Greene Pl.

PUBLICITY

Publicity includes press releases, calendar listings in local publications, display ads, flyers, posters, brochure mailings, and the SONYA web site.

Studio Stroll artists are responsible for their own mailings and are encouraged to promote their location as well as cross-promoting with neighboring registered Studio Stroll Artists. The images and statements submitted with the artist's annual membership application will be used for promoting their artwork and their location.

WEB SITE

The SONYA web site, www.sonyaonline.org, features each Studio Stroll and Prelude Exhibition artist with their own web page. The page will include two samples of the artist's work, a biographical or artist's statement, and a link to their personal web site, email, and/or other contact info. Because these pages are used to promote your work, it is important that images submitted for your web page be of work that is currently available for exhibition and/or sale.

PRELUDE EXHIBITION, APRIL 24 – MAY 18

Artists registered as participants in the Studio Stroll are invited to display one small work that represents the larger body of work that can be seen at their Studio Stroll location. The Prelude Exhibition will be held at 394 Waverly Ave, from April 24th through May 18th and will also be open during the Studio Stroll weekend, May 17th & 18th.

MEMBERS ONLY STROLL NIGHTS, MAY 12 & 13

New this year, is our answer to the long time complaint of Stroll artists not being able to visit other Stroll artists' studios and galleries. On Monday, May 12th and Tuesday, May 13th, from 6 to 9pm, Stroll artists will open their studios for a SONYA

members only preview tour. One half of the Stroll artists will be open one night, the other half will be open the following night.

CHAMPAGNE CURATORS TOUR, MAY 14 & 15

Successfully inaugurated in 2006, the Champagne Curators Tour offers art curators and buyers a chauffeured tour of private studio visits during the week preceding the Stroll and offers more networking for those SONYA members who wish to further their careers with exhibitions and gallery representation. Stroll Artists can opt in or out of participating in the Champagne Tour.

Curators will be invited via email and mail to view the web pages (at www.sonyaonline.org) of the Studio Stroll Artists designated as available for Curators' visits during four scheduled open studio sessions the business week prior to the Stroll, May 14 & 15. The sessions are: Wednesday, May 14, 1-4 pm and 5-9 pm; Thursday, May 15, 1-4 pm and 5-9 pm (subject to change). Artists to be visited are chosen by the invited curators, based on the Artist's web page or their prior knowledge, not SONYA staff nor the Curators Tour coordinator.

In order to participate in the Champagne Curators Tour, artists must

- Complete their Stroll registration by April 1st, including submitting all payments, information and images required.
- Have reserved the four possible visit sessions on their calendar till at least April 30th or till notification of artist visits are finalized.
- Be prepared to show their work to visiting curators during any of the visiting session days and times.

One champagne bottle per studio will be provided by our local wine shops as refreshment for each visit. Artists are encouraged, if suitable, to complement this with light refreshments (club soda, crackers/cheese, fruit) of their own.

SALES

There is a 30% commission fee on work sold at the Prelude Exhibition venues. SONYA charges no commission fees for work sold at the registered artists Studio Stroll locations.

ELIGIBILITY

All artists registering for the Studio Stroll and Prelude Exhibition must be active SONYA members in good standing. Artists participating in the Prelude Exhibition must also be registered for the Studio Stroll. Artists, age 21 and over, who live, exhibit or have studios in the SONYA community of Brooklyn, NY are eligible to join SONYA.

SONYA Group Members may register for the Studio Stroll and Prelude Exhibition by registering the gallery/organization as a whole, thereby selecting one artwork for the Prelude Exhibition to represent their group and paying one registration fee.

All work displayed must be original fine art created by the registered artist for that location.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES AND FEES

The Registration Fee is \$25. Deadline for completing registration is **March 31, 2008** (postmarked). Fee covers registration for both the Studio Stroll and the Prelude Exhibition.

Participants will be notified by phone or email when materials are received. Only those who have completed the registration process, including full fee payment and signed agreement, will be considered registered and therefore listed in publicity and signage materials. Registered artists will receive a Stroll and press checklist.

CANCELLATIONS

In the event that this event must be cancelled, participants will be notified promptly. There is no rain date.

If you must cancel your participation, please immediately call the Studio Stroll Chairperson. Registration Fees are non-refundable.

PUBLIC ACCESS

Artists and organizations are responsible for securing permission from landlords, studio mates, etc. to allow public access to their Studio Stroll space. Artists are expected to have their site open and be present (or have a representative present) during the tour hours on both Saturday and Sunday of the tour weekend.

PRELUDE EXHIBITION DELIVERY AND PICKUP

Please select artwork that is no larger than 48 inches (height) by 36 inches (width) for this exhibition. Effort will be made to accommodate all media. Artwork must be delivered on Sunday, April 20th, 5-7 PM or Monday, April 21st, 6-8 PM, to 394 Waverly Ave. Artwork must be picked up on Monday, May 19th, 5-7 PM or Tuesday May 20th 5-7 PM. No accommodations will be made for storing artwork after this date!

DOOR PEOPLE

Artists are responsible for recruiting and directing their own door people. Door people are responsible for greeting and directing tour-goers, counting the visitors to the location, and encouraging them to sign the guest book. They are invited to attend the Prelude Exhibition Reception as our honored guests!

VOLUNTEER TIME

The Volunteer Coordinator will contact SONYA members who have elected to volunteer their time as part of their annual membership fee payment.

STUDIO PREP

Registered artists are responsible for setting up their own studio and displaying their work to the public. Each location will receive signs and banners to display outside the studio/gallery. Artists may also consider having a guest book, promotional materials, and extra tour maps readily available to visitors.

On the tour days, registered artists must use SONYA published signage to designate their location. Extra signs and banners will be available in case of loss or damage. The signs and banners must be displayed by noon of each tour day.

FOOD & DRINK

It is each location's choice whether or not to serve refreshments in their studio or gallery.

SECURITY

SONYA is not liable or responsible for the security of artists' artwork or studio space. Artists are responsible for ensuring the safety and security of their artwork, equipment, display, and any of their personal belongings in their home/studio.

AGREEMENT

As a registered participant of the SONYA STUDIO STROLL and PRELUDE EXHIBITION 2008, I agree to the following conditions:

- I will secure permission from my landlord, studio mates, etc. to allow public access to my space.
- I will be present or have a representative present at my site during the tour hours on both days of the STUDIO STROLL 2008.
- I will obtain the proper city permits if I display artwork on city owned property.
- If I have registered my SONYA membership under the reduced rate that includes 6 hours of volunteer time, I will make every effort to fulfill this commitment (at least in part) towards preparations for the Studio Stroll And Prelude Exhibition 2008.
- I will contact the Studio Stroll Director immediately if I am unable to participate in the Studio Stroll and Prelude Exhibition 2008.
- I will ensure that the event is publicized by displaying SONYA published signage and logo banners at my location during the Studio Stroll And Prelude Exhibition 2008. I agree to display SONYA published location signage.
- I will ensure the safety and security of the artwork, equipment, display, and personal property at my site.
